

# INTERNAL FISHING REGULATIONS

**It is strictly forbidden to fish in the pond without prior authorisation** from the Management. **Any violation will result in immediate exclusion from the site.** Before fishing, you must report to the campsite reception to declare your presence and pay for a fishing permit. Holders of an annual permit are also required to report on each arrival. **No refunds will be given if fishing is interrupted at the customer's initiative.** Anglers must present their fishing permit during checks. This fishing permit:

- implies full and complete acceptance of these rules;
- is non-transferable and valid only for the period indicated;
- is priced according to the length of stay (information available at reception).

**Any inappropriate behaviour** (insults, threats, deliberate damage, refusal to present the fishing licence, disrespect for nature, etc.) **will result in the immediate and permanent exclusion** of the person(s) concerned.

## GENERAL RULES APPLICABLE TO ALL OUR PONDS

### **The prohibitions** in force on our 10 fishing ponds:

- ⊖ Driving at speeds exceeding 10 km/h within the campsite and around the ponds.
- ⊖ Fishing outside opening hours (8am-7pm or 7am-10pm).
- ⊖ Swimming (including animals) and the use of boats.
- ⊖ Campfires are prohibited (barbecues are available free of charge!).
- ⊖ The use of harpoons, double or triple hooks and barbed hooks (ponds 1 and 10).
- ⊖ Leaving your lines unattended.
- ⊖ Access to the ponds with motorised vehicles (quad bikes, motorbikes, etc.).

### **Good neighbour rules on our ponds**

- Respect the fishing hours: from 7am to 10pm for white fish and carp fishing, and from 8am to 7pm for trout fishing.
- Young children must be supervised at all times by a responsible adult.
- **Be courteous and respectful of your neighbours.** Maintain a reasonable distance between each fishing spot and do not cut across the path of other anglers: always fish in front of you.
- **Remove your rods** from the water when you **leave your fishing spot.**
- Avoid any noise pollution: loudspeakers playing music at high volume are prohibited.
- **Do not leave any nylon line, hooks or rubbish on the ground.**
- **Dogs are allowed** (except categories 1 and 2), provided they are **kept on a leash** and their waste is picked up.

- **Barbecues are available for your use free** of charge. Please clean them after use so that they are left clean for the next users.
- A **traffic flow system** and signage have been put in place to make it easier for you to get around the campsite. **Please respect these.**

**Let's respect this place: keep it clean and protect the environment:**



- ✓ Ashtrays and cigarette butt bins are available for your use.
- ✓ Glass, plastic, cardboard and other waste must be disposed of in one
  - of the nine bins provided around the ponds (colour-coded according to the
  - type of waste).

## PÊCHE À LA CARPE (No Kill fishing)

**Pond No. 10 – Open daily from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.**

**Fishing is carried out according to the following rules:**

- Number of rods: Maximum of one rod per angler.
- Hooks: Barbless, size 8 maximum.
- Required equipment: Landing mat, water bucket and large landing net. (A landing mat is available at reception if you forget yours.)
- Large landing net: Mandatory for the welfare of the fish.
- Handling fish: Weighing, photographing and releasing fish must be done quickly and respectfully.

**Common sense and respect for the rules:**

- Strict adherence to your location and fishing area (maximum 6 metres).
- All bait is permitted, except for uncooked seeds.
- All carp must be returned to the water in pond no. 10.
- It is essential to disinfect any wounds on the carp when hooking them. Disinfectant is available at the campsite reception.


**Prohibitions on our carp pond:**

- ⊖ Fishing with bread and floating pellets (surface fishing) is prohibited.
- ⊖ Baiting with flour and earth is prohibited.
- ⊖ The use of keepnets, bait boats, drones, echo sounders and float tubes is strictly prohibited.
- ⊖ Storage bags and keepnets are prohibited.

**Any act of theft or mutilation of a fish will result in immediate exclusion.**

**For battery fishing on the carp pond:**

This type of fishing is prohibited in all ponds.

# WHITE FISHING (No Kill fishing)

**Pond No. 1 – Open every day from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.**

- Catch and release: All fish must be released immediately (No Kill fishing).
- Permit: All anglers must have a fishing permit.
- Battery fishing: Strictly prohibited. Casting permitted for pike.
- Number of rods: Maximum of one rod per angler; for pike fishing, only one rod is permitted.
- In the event of a hook-up: Cut the line immediately to minimise injury to the fish.
- It is essential to disinfect any wounds. Disinfectant is available at the campsite reception.

## Prohibitions on our pond at Le Blanc

- ⊖ It is prohibited to use a cloth to handle fish (risk of mortality).
- ⊖ It is prohibited to take fish, alive or dead, except for pike over 60 cm.
- ⊖ Barbed hooks, bait boats and keepnets are prohibited.

# TROUT FISHING (8 a.m. to 7 p.m.)

- ⊖ **It is strictly forbidden to fish in any pond other than the one reserved for this purpose.**
- **If you catch a carp** (mirror, white amur, common), it must be carefully **returned to the water** in the same pond immediately. These fish help to regulate vegetation.

## Common pond no. 2

- Open:
- Half-day: 8 a.m.–1 p.m. or 2 p.m.–7 p.m.
- Full day: 8 a.m.–7 p.m.
- Unlimited number of catches. Please do not release trout back into the water.
- Maximum of one rod per angler (bait or casting), single hook only.
- Respect the trajectory and distance from neighbours.
- ⊖ **Spoons and all types of bait prohibited.**
- ⊖ **Triple hooks prohibited.**

## Private ponds no. 3 to no. 9

- Open by reservation. A deposit is required at the time of booking.
- The tenant is responsible for their guests (within reason).
- Please ensure that you limit any disturbances and/or noise pollution.
- Unlimited number of rods, anglers and catches.
- **Single hooks only.**
- Please respect the boundaries of the reserved pond.
